Student Teaching Abroad

Students interested in completing part of their student teaching experience abroad must be approved to do so by the Education faculty. A minimum 7 weeks of student teaching must be completed under the direct supervision of Augsburg College supervisors within the Education Department's service area. Students will register for a minimum three courses of student teaching. It is understood that the student has already been accepted into the teacher licensure program of the Augsburg Education Department.

Steps to student teach overseas:

- Meet with the Student Teaching Placement Director to receive an application one year in advance of readiness to student teach. Readiness means that all coursework will be completed before student teaching in Minnesota is begun.
- All PPST and Praxis II tests must be taken and passed before student teaching begins.
- **Submit an essay** to the Placement Director describing why you want to student teach abroad.
- Complete an application from the Augsburg Center for Global Education.
- Complete and submit an application to the University of MN-Morris. Student teaching abroad placements are arranged via the assistance of the University of MN-Morris. This institution provides experienced supervisors who travel to placements in most major cities of countries throughout the world. Please note that there is a \$300 non-refundable fee required by MN-Morris at the time of application.

• Cost

Students pay regular tuition and student teaching fees directly to Augsburg College. Students are responsible for airfare to their international destination and for room and board in the host city. Cost of living will vary depending upon site.
